## Gospel of Matthew 28

#### The Resurrection

1	Now after the Sabbath, toward the dawn of the first day of the
	week,
	Mary Magdalene and the other Mary went to see the tomb.
2	And behold, there was a great earthquake,
	for an angel of the Lord descended from heaven
	and came and rolled back the stone and sat on it.
3	His appearance was like lightning, and his clothing white as snow.
4	And for fear of him the guards trembled and became like dead men.
5	But the engel and to the warman

- <sup>5</sup> But the angel said to the women,"Do not be afraid, for I know that you seek Jesus who was crucified.
- <sup>6</sup> He is not here, for he has risen, as he said. Come, see the place where he lay.
- <sup>7</sup> Then go quickly and tell his disciples that he has risen from the dead, and behold, he is going before you to Galilee; there you will see him. See, I have told you."
- <sup>8</sup> So they departed quickly from the tomb with fear and great joy, and ran to tell his disciples.
- <sup>9</sup> And behold, Jesus met them and said, "Greetings!"
- And they came up and took hold of his feet and worshipped him.
- <sup>10</sup> Then Jesus said to them, "Do not be afraid; go and tell my brothers to go to Galilee, and there they will see me."

#### The Report of the Guard

- While they were going,behold, some of the guard went into the cityand told the chief priests all that had taken place.
- <sup>12</sup> And when they had assembled with the elders and taken counsel,
- they gave a sufficient sum of money to the soldiers
- <sup>13</sup> and said,
  - "Tell people, His disciples came by night and stole him away while we were asleep."
- <sup>14</sup> And if this comes to the governor's ears,
- we will satisfy him and keep you out of trouble."
- So they took the money and did as they were directed.And this story has been spread among the Jews to this day.



#### The Great Commission

- <sup>16</sup> Now the eleven disciples went to Galilee,
- to the mountain to which Jesus had directed them.
- <sup>17</sup> And when they saw him they worshipped him, but some doubted.
- <sup>18</sup> And Jesus came and said to them,
- "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.
- <sup>19</sup> Go therefore and make disciples of all nations,
  - baptising them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,
- teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age."
