The *Isaiah Journey* is a working group of the Bishops' Conference and has grown out of the need for a pastoral-spiritual response to the suffering of victims and survivors of abuse in the Church.

It may help you to know that should you make a disclosure of abuse, this is treated in the strictest confidence. It is the policy of the Catholic Church in England & Wales to report to the statutory authorities all allegations of abuse made against those working in the name of the Church, regardless of whether the allegations or concerns related to a person's behaviour in relation to their role within the Church or another setting. We are able to report allegations of abuse anonymously, i.e. without giving the survivor's details. Only information that is strictly necessary, proportionate and mandatory to share will be shared, and only to those who need to know for the purpose of safeguarding you and others. A safeguarding co-ordinator will share a privacy notice with you.
