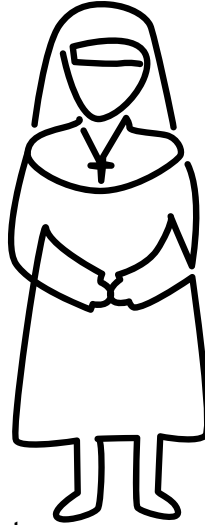
Trusting in Jesus to guide us to him and that his love will always win - even when it's hard.
