- The Capital City is Lusaka. Located in the Southeast of the country, Ndola is 200 miles north of Lusaka
- 2. Zambia is a country struggling with widespread poverty and devastating health epidemics. It is among the world's poorest nations
- 3. Life expectancy at birth is under 40 years
- 4. Out of a total population of 11.46 million, nearly one million Zambians are HIV positive or have AIDS and over a half-million Zambian children have been orphaned as a result of HIV/Aids
- 5. Malaria is the major reason nearly 20% of all Zambian babies do not live to see their fifth birthday
- In many parts of Zambia illnesses and conditions such as Cerebral Palsy and
 Epilepsy are believed to be due to evil spirits or a results of wrong-doing in a past
 life
- 7. The 2000 census showed that 2.9% of the population in Zambia have disabilities
